Renovations in any room in the home are eligible, **except kitchens**. Each entry is limited to a single room. Entries may also entail interior and exterior work, and can involve any size renovation, including the whole house, reconfiguration or existing spaces and/or addition of new space.

B. Construction Technology

This refers to measures beyond code requirements to make the project more energy efficient, durable and environmentally responsible. The energy efficiency and indoor air quality sections may not apply to all projects (i.e. decks and other outdoor living areas).

Using point form, comment on the following items, as applicable, and include supporting evidence from manufacturers of the products and technologies used, where possible.

Energy efficient features, including the building envelope, mechanical systems, site orientation, use of materials with low embodied energy and other features (if relevant, include documented comments on reduced energy costs and increased occupant comfort).



Materials and operating systems that increase the durability of the house

Techniques used to reduce waste, re-use materials, and mitigate negative impacts on plant and animal life

Technologies to improve indoor air quality and/or otherwise provide healthier living conditions for the occupants

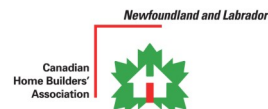
